Note that the special names of units never bear a capital letter (write henry not Henry). However, the first letter of the symbol is capitalized when it is based upon a scientist's name. Thus, the symbol for henry is H not h.

Table 2B below shows the symbols for the special names in Table 2A above.

N.B.

Note the raised dot that replaces the multiplication sign when two units are combined, such as in Pa·s and N·m

By referring to the Wildi SI Charts you will always find the correct symbols to be used in your writings and publications.
